2008 STALLION FUTURITY COMMITTEE MEETING – DEC. 19th

Stallion Futurity meeting was held at Johnnies in Tulsa at 7:00 p.m. Everyone that arrived was cheerful and full of good ideas. People in attendance were: Jim & Brooke Cain, Fred & Bev Cargile, Velma & Rhonda Boodt, Vicky Carnahan, Michelle Scrimshaw, Becky Amason, Christian and sister, and Dewayne & Barb McCalip.

Topics that were discussed were:

1. When showing in the Futurity class you must enter and show in the open class.
Answer: Yes, the Tulsa Fair requires you to in order to collect your \$\$\$\$\$\$ if you win anything.
2. Advertising for 2008-2010 Stallion Futurity Auction.
Beverly has put ads out in the Arkansas, Oklahoma City Club, Breeders Network and putting blurb on Craig's list, Equine hits, and Dream horse. Will continue to always look for more free/less expensive places to advertise. Current place that the club advertises is with the Hand Gallop flyer. It cost \$250.00 per article.
3. May show 2009/2011 stallion Futurity
Committee wants to try and get the excitement back up. Looking into a big movie screen. Movie screen will display all stallions and babies if the stallion owner desires. It would run the course of the show, so people have the chance to view stallions at anytime. The appropriate music will play with the stallion. Finger foods, drinks, cheese and cracker type foods will be available during the show.
Also will have some one read about stallions in the futurity and possibly show there stallions and babies if there's time at the show. Cont. talking with the show committee on this issue. Pictures of the stallions and babies will be available during the May show and Tulsa Fair.
3. Yearling jackpot was also brought up. Possible 90% payback with payouts to 8th place. There would be the yearling jackpot and open class. Brooke Cain and Barb McCalip will be looking into this class for possibly the May show.

FAIR SHOW 2009/2011

1. What can we do at the Fair that would not take long but get some interest with the Stallion Futurity? Idea: Place the Big Screen TV and display all stallions again plus babies. Have set up the entire show. Make fliers and pass around to people.
2. Pictures of stallion futurity foals. Put signs on there stall doors if it's a futurity baby and what sire it is plus if it's for sale.
3. Have amateur taking pictures of the babies after each class. If not able to make it right after class then have a sign up sheet for them. It will be available if the owner wants the foal's picture taken.
4. Beverly Cargile will try and contact Stan Morey for possibly putting on a halter clinic. Try to coordinate the halter clinic with the stallion futurity. More details later.
5. Another idea was to have a Halloween party with the stallion Auction.
6. Jim Cain is checking with Rick Wells (News) to advertise the stallion auction.
7. Rhonda Boodt checking with RFDTV for advertising stallion auction.

Stallion Futurity Committee voted in Beverly Cargile to be the marketing director plus chair person. Becky Amason is the treasurer only. Questions' pertaining to money goes to Becky and the rest goes to Beverly.

1. Phone in and computerized purchase contracts of a stallion have only a 2 week time limit. The date starts the day they call in and state they want to purchase that breeding. Michelle will list the stallion as "Pending" with the date on it. They have two weeks to pay Becky for the breeding other wise it nulls the contract. Live auction, the money has to be paid that day.
