DELEGATE REPORT

At 8 AM on November 16, 2010 the National Convention was officially open with A board of Director meeting from 8 AM to 5 PM. Committee meetings were held from 1:45 to 10 PM with a plenary session from 5 to 8 PM where all resolutions were reviewed with proponent.

On Thursday November 18, 2010 General session was opened by Craig Christiansen master of ceremonies. Program was turned over to Lance Walters, President reported that AHA financial status was much improved and continues to improve. AHA has no financial liability other than to it's self. There is \$500,000.00 owed to the Sweepstakes Committee and \$486,000.00 owed to the Judges and Steward Committee. This is a result from misuse of funds two years ago.

President Walters reported the National Distance ride was cancelled due to a possible \$30,000.00 to \$40,000.00 loss which was projected from low number of entries. He also advised that growth of the youth membership is high priority. AHA is making every attempt to lower fees where possible.

Treasurer report was given by Davis Corning, Region 5. The club had a profit of \$155,000.00 for the year with \$134,000.00 cash gain. The numbers do not include the National show held in Tulsa Oct 2010. The current projection is the show will have an overall profit but is currently showing \$118,000.00 loss. Final accounting for the show should be complete in early December 2010.

Announcement was made that National convention in 2011 will be held in Vancouver BC and make sure if you plan to attend you will need a current passport and speed limits are metric. In 2012 Convention will be held in Denver Colorado at Denver Marriott Tech Center on November 14 – 18 and 2013 will be held in Lexington, Kentucky at the Hyatt Regency Lexington hotel with overflow to Hilton Downtown Lexington November 20-24.

The new Arabian Horse Gallery opened just prior to the World Equestrian Games at the Lexington Horse Park. Those who attended took time to tour the Gallery and reported that it is outstanding and a must see for all Arabian owners. You may make donations to the Gallery on line at "ArabianHorseGalleries.com" or send to Arabian Horse Trust, 303 Water Mark Dr., Peach Tree City, GA 30269.

Guest speaker was James J. Hickey Jr., president of American Horse Council in Washington D.C. His report advised that the NAIS program is still in congress and being looked at. It has been converted to a disease tracking system and most likely will not require chips for all horses.

Hamp Johnston of the Arabian Jockey Club and Racing Commission gave a report on the Keenland race track in Kentucky held Arabian races during the World Equestrian Games exposed the sport to over 500,000 people and had an average purse of \$8200.00. The future of Arabian horse racing is growing rapidly.

On 19 November general session was continued and resolutions were presented and acted on as follows.

- 10-1 AHA membership to run on Calendar year was defeated
- 10-5 Revision of Chapter 3 Code of Ethics was withdrawn by proponent
- 10-7 Addition of Achievement Award points for beginner novice and Intermediate Eventing levels was withdrawn by the proponent
- 10-8 USEF Arabian Committee Authority was withdrawn by proponent
- 10-15 Controlled Paddock (USEF/EC) was defeated
- 10-20 Amateur Owner Hunter Under Saddle was withdrawn by proponent
- 10-26 Breeding/Gelding in-hand Scoring System (USEF/EC) was defeated
- 10-36 ATR Boxing Pattern Cow Horse Class was withdrawn
- 10-40 Showing of Sport Horses (USEF/EC) was withdrawn by proponent
- 10-43 Rescind BOD motion #16-5/16/09 on Humane Treatment of Equine Breeds & Livestock was withdrawn by proponent

All other resolutions were approved by vote and will become effective on published effective date.

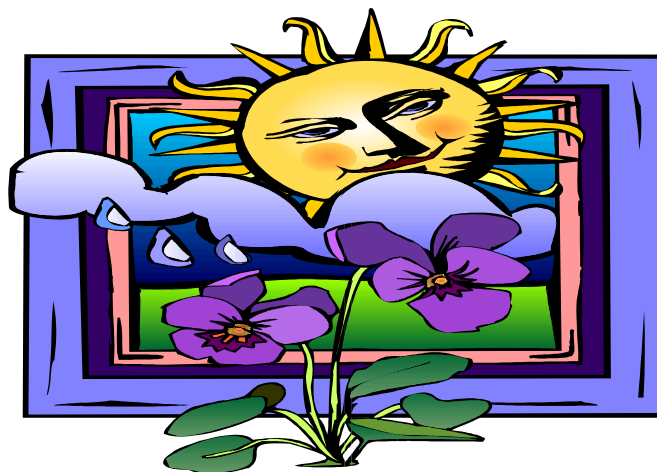
