2. Fees Payable to GCAHA.
3. Photocopies required to be sent with entries:
 - Horse's Registration Certification: both sides.
If under one year of age, proof of
 - Proof of Ownership (if applicable): In the case of a sale or lease, it is required that a copy of the sale contract or lease, or statement from the owner be submitted with the copy of the current registration certificate.
 - USEF Membership cards (owner, trainer, rider, driver & handler).
 - AHA Membership cards (owner, trainer, rider, driver, & handler).
 - USEF Amateur Certification (if applicable).

Copies of your actual current AHA/USEF membership cards are required or single event fees will be charged. AHA affidavits are no longer available. If you do not have proof of current AHA membership you must pay the AHA single event member fee. USEF affidavits are no longer available. If you do not have proof of current USEF membership you must pay the USEF non-member fee. Exhibitors showing in Amateur Owner classes must be listed as an owner of the horse on the registration papers of the horse they are exhibiting.

The DW Raven++++// Memorial Trophy is a perpetual award that has been established to honor DW Raven++++//, who passed away on March 9, 2008. He was an 11 year old Anglo Arabian gelding who excelled in the Sport Horse division. He competed in Sport Horse In Hand, Sport Horse Under Saddle, Working Hunter, Hunter Hack, and Dressage. In 2006, he earned the Arabian Horse Association Legion of Excellence Award and the Legion of Masters Award in 2007, after only three years of competition. DW Raven++++// was a two-time unanimous National Champion in Hunter Hack AAOTR and ATR, and won a total of 7 Top Tens at two Sport Horse National Championships. In addition, he garnered 13 Regional Champions, 6 Reserve Championship, and 5 Top Five Awards. With this High Point Sport Horse Award, our desire is to honor DW Raven++++// and his accomplishments and to continue the memory of this wonderful horse for years to come.



The DW Raven++++// Memorial Trophy will be awarded to the
High Point Purebred or
Half-Arabian/Anglo-Arabian Sport Horse
and
Reserve High Point Purebred or Half-Arabian/Anglo-Arabian award

Points will be awarded in Sport Horse In Hand Open and ATH, Sport Horse Under Saddle Open and ATR, Hunter Hack and Sport Horse Show Hack. The horse will accumulate points based on first through sixth place in each applicable class. The points will be distributed as follows: 1st=6 points, 2nd=5 points, 3rd=4 points, 4th=3 points, 5th=2 points, and 6th=1 point. The horse with the highest number of points will be the High Point Sport Horse. Second highest number of points will be Reserve High Point Sport Horse

The Arabian and Open Dressage shows are separate shows being run by two different managements.

Pay just one stall fee for all shows.

EXHIBITORS PLEASE READ IF YOU ARE PLANNING ON SHOWING AT THE OPEN DRESSAGE SHOWS:

USEF RULE

DR119 2. Horses may compete in no more than one Licensed Competition on the same day and are limited to a maximum of three Dressage rides per day at Fourth Level and below or two Dressage rides per day above Fourth Level.

This is for horses only; exhibitors can show in both shows on the same day.
Horses can show in the open dressage show Saturday and show in the Arabian show Sunday.
Horses can show in the open dressage show Sunday and show in the Arabian show Saturday.

Sport horse classes have been moved to Friday because of this rule.

Open Qualifying Competition Programs

For Horse Achievement Awards, Amateur Achievement Awards, Dressage Rider Award, AHA Qualification Programs (Dressage/Working Hunter/Jumper/Hunter Hack/Cutting/Working Cow Horse/Reining/Reined Cow Horse/Eventing/Trials/Combined Driving/Carriage Pleasure Driving/Driven Dressage)

The annual enrollment fee for the Open Dressage Qualification Program is \$35 per horse per year and the enrollment and scores must be postmarked/electronic transaction dated to the AHA office within 30 days of the competition date.

If the enrollment or scores are sent in after 30 days of the competition date then the fee is \$65 per horse per year.

The enrollment year is considered to be from January 1 - December 31.

Only scores will count for qualifications. There will be no qualification points earned from Open Dressage shows based on placings.

Results reporting

Shows must be sanctioned by USEF/USDF or EC.

Results must be sent to the AHA office on the official Open Qualifying Show/Event Report Form. Copies of the applicable pages of the prize list must be included verifying the judges, show secretary & show manager as well as the show name and class list.

The report form must be filled out in full, including the horse's registration number and the rider's current member number.

If the report form cannot be signed by the show secretary or manager then the following can be used as verification along with the results form:

- Print out from the USEF or USDF websites of the horse's competition record with the Dressage scores listed.
- Copy of the test score sheet with attached verification of the show being sanctioned by USEF/USDF or EC.

In order for results to be recorded the owner and the rider both must hold current AHA Competition Level Memberships.

Only scores of 55% or better will be recorded for Intro through 3rd Levels and only scores of 50% or better will be recorded for 4th Level and higher.

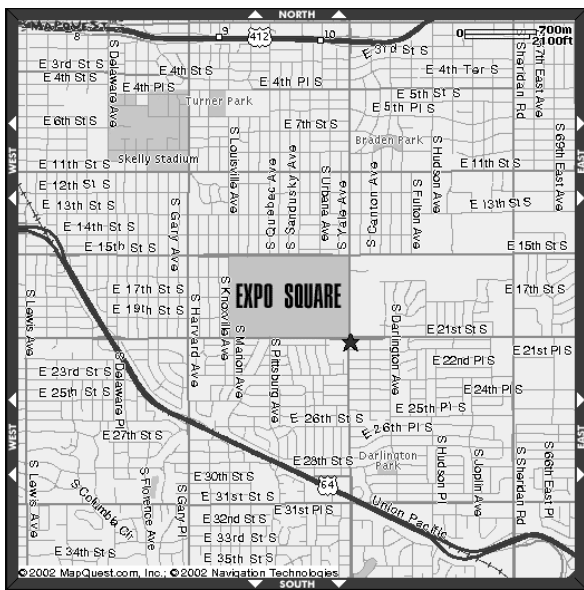

GENERAL RULES

This horse show is conducted in accordance with the Rules of the United States Equestrian Federation, Arabian Horse Division. The official Rule Book of USEF will prevail for this show.

This premium list is based on the rules of the current Rule Book. Any changes or corrections of rules will automatically become a part of this premium list. Each participant in the show is responsible for knowledge of and is subject to the USEF Rules. The Show Committee shall decide questions not covered by USEF rules and its decisions will be final.

USEF REQUIREMENTS:

- A) A non-member of USEF who wishes to participate as a rider, driver, handler, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at this show must pay a non-member registration fee of \$30.
- B) A non-member showing in any amateur class must pay an amateur certification fee of \$30.00 if they have not already done that during the current year at a previous show.
- C) Amateurs: All adult riders/drivers/handlers in "Amateur" classes (including futurity classes) must have in their possession an Amateur Certification Membership card issued by USEF or make application for such card with the Show Secretary at least one hour prior to showing in any Amateur Class. If you are not a member of USEF and do not have an Amateur Certification card you can:
 - 1. Pay a \$30 non-member fee and a \$30 Amateur Certification fee
 - 2. Or become a USEF Senior member. Senior membership is \$55 which includes Amateur Certification.
- D) USEF Membership affidavits are no longer available. If you do not have your USEF card you must pay the non-member fee.
- E) There is a mandatory fee of \$16.00 per horse (\$8 drugs and med & \$8 USEF).
- F) A photocopy of your USEF membership card must accompany your entry.
- G) Walk-trot and leadline riders are exempt from USEF non-member fees.

USEF MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS:

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$30 nonmember registration fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

Federation Entry Agreement

By entering a Federation-licensed Competition and signing this entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaultor or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of The United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. (the "Federation") and the local rules of Green Country Arabian Classic (Competition). I agree to be bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the Federation and of the competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the Rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the Competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cable - casts, broadcasts, internet, film, new media or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Federation rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State. See GR908.4.

AHA REQUIREMENTS:

- A) All exhibitors entered in this event must be a current AHA member with a competition card, join AHA at the show, or pay a Single Event Membership fee of \$35.00 per person. This includes any owner, trainer, driver, rider, or halter handler who exhibits horses in the show ring or signs the entry form as the responsible person for any individual's horse. A photocopy of your AHA membership card must accompany your entry.
- B) AHA Membership affidavits are no longer available. If you do not have your AHA card you must pay the single event Member fee.
- C) There is a mandatory \$3.00 per horse fee for AHA judges' commission and education/evaluation, Resolution 9-90. RESOLUTION 9-90
- D) There is a \$3.00 per horse fee collected for AHA.
- E) Walk-trot and leadline riders are exempt from AHA non-member fees.

USEF RULEBOOK AR101 ELIGIBILITY TO COMPETE: Purebred: Horses shown in this division must have been issued a certificate of registration from the Arabian Horse Registry of America, Inc., or the Arabian Horse Association as a Purebred Arabian and/or the Canadian Arabian Horse Registry (or in the case of a foreign entry, which has not been issued said certificate of registration, have been issued a Competition Visa by the Arabian Horse Association), or, **if under one year of age, be eligible for registry, and registration applied for** (Exception: AR249.1) **and must be entered under their full registered name.** (Only weanlings that have had registration applied for may show without registration papers). A copy of the registration papers showing the owner of record with the Arabian Horse Association must be submitted with entry form at the time of making entry; competition management is responsible for notifying exhibitors of this requirement. A copy of the registration papers will be returned when exhibitors pick up their numbers. In the case of a sale or lease, it is required that a contract of the sale or lease, or statement from owner be submitted with the copy of the registration papers. (Exception: Horses under one year of age.

Half-Arabians and Anglo-Arabians: Horses shown in this section must have been issued a certificate of registration from the International Arabian Horse Association or the Arabian Horse Association or the Canadian Partbred Arabian Register as a Half-Arabian or Anglo-Arabian, **or if under one year of age, be eligible for registry and registration applied for and must be entered under their full registered name.**

\$\$ CLASSES are points classes for the new AHA Breeders Sweepstakes points program. **ANYONE CAN ENTER THESE CLASSES.** Point enrollments must be made prior to the event in which the horse will compete for prize money. All Points enrollments must be made directly to the AHA office, show secretaries may not accept these enrollments. Only sweepstakes horses with a paid up enrollment, **prior to the start of the show**, will earn points from these classes at this show.

ACCIDENT PREPAREDNESS PLAN: The show complies with Article GR1213 of the USEF Rules. An EMT is on the show grounds during each session of the show. In addition, a Tulsa ambulance, if needed, will be summoned by a call to 911. Should the EMT or ambulance be needed, contact the Show Office or the show arena Paddock Manager. The EMT or the ambulance will be contacted. The Show Veterinarian can be contacted by the show office.

ARENAS: Main Arena is 135' by 240' and is sandy loam and clay. Warm-up arena is sandy loam and clay. Arabian exhibitors will use the Mustang warm-up arena (west of Mustang arena) and breezeway area. Additional warm-up areas and times: Ford warm-up arena will be available all day Friday and after the dressage show ends on Saturday.

BAD CHECKS: There will be a \$50.00 handling fee charged for any returned checks. Action in accordance with USEF rules will be taken against any owner, exhibitor or trainer who does not make a returned check good and will be reported.

BARN OFFICE HOURS, ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURES: Barn manager is Ed Davis, 918-557-9969. Contact Ed for arrival and departure if earlier than May 2nd or later than midnight May 6th. Early arrival or late departure is \$30 per day per stall used. All stall doors are locked and will be opened by the barn manager upon your arrival. ***TULSA FAIRGROUNDS AND/OR GCAHA IS NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY ITEMS LET UNATTENDED.***

CALL FOR CLASSES: The two minute gate will be enforced. The gate will close two minutes after the first horse enters the ring or in cases with large classes taking more than two minutes, after the entry of the final horse in a continuous string of horses. If tack changes are necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to notify the gate person and request a three-minute gate hold. Note: Due to unforeseeable problems with the mechanical devices, the paddock and barn calls over the PA system must be considered a COURTESY. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to be sure that his/her horse is at the gate at the prescribed time.

CANCELLATION OF CLASSES DUE TO EMERGENCIES: In the event that a class, or a series of classes, or all or part of the competition is cancelled due to an accident, storm, or other emergency after the start of the show (defined as initial Move-In Day), no refund of entry fees will be made.

CONCESSIONS: are available on the grounds.

DOGS: Dogs will be permitted on the show grounds, but **MUST** be on leashes at all times. No dogs will be allowed in the show arena.

ENTRIES: All entries must be made on the official entry blank for this show and filled out entirely. A horse must be entered in the name of his registered owner(s) only and must be entered under its full registered name. A photocopy of all AHA membership cards, USEF membership cards, and registration papers must accompany your entry form. All entries must be accompanied by a valid check or money order for the full amount of all fees made out to GCAHA. A signature is required by the parent if a minor is showing.

FARRIER: A farrier will be available on show grounds beginning May 3rd or on call with number posted at office. An official Show Farrier will be available on the grounds. No other farrier will be permitted to work on the grounds without registering with the show committee. Exhibitors wishing to use their private farrier must have the farrier apply at the Show Office and pay a registration fee of \$100 before they can work on the show grounds.

FEED & BEDDING: Pete's Feed - Pete Wedelin 918-543-3724 (B) 918-630-1306 (Cell). If arriving after hours and you need shavings, please contact Pete's Feed ahead of time.

HEALTH REGULATIONS: All horses must have a negative Coggins Test dated within twelve (12) months (must be original not photocopy). All out of state horses must also be accompanied by an Official Health Certificate issued within 30 days of arrival that identifies the animals listed, including all vaccinations, and date and results of required test. **THE ABOVE ITEMS SHOULD BE CARRIED WITH YOU – DO NOT FORWARD WITH YOUR ENTRY.** Any animals brought into Oklahoma must observe all regulations of the State of Oklahoma, Animal Health Division. Any horse that develops a communicable disease must be removed from the show grounds.

INDEBTEDNESS TO SHOW: Any exhibitor who fails to settle his indebtedness to this show will automatically be reported to AHA and USEF. Any exhibitor who fails to settle his indebtedness in full to a FARRIER or VETERINARIAN for his/her services during the show **BEFORE LEAVING THE GROUNDS** will be barred from taking part in future shows.

JUDGES: This show will be judged according to the single judge systems. In the event that an official is unable to perform his duties, the Show Committee reserves the right to substitute an official according to USEF rules. It is a violation of USEF Rules to commit any act or make remarks during the show that are considered offensive or made with intent to influence or cast aspersions on the judging and any exhibitor may be barred from the show for this offense by the Show Committee. No contact shall be made with the Judges during the period of the show unless accompanied by a member of the Show Committee designated by the committee for such purpose. Further, no exhibitor shall approach a Judge regarding a decision unless he first obtains permissions from the Steward, who shall arrange an appointment with the Judge at a proper time and place.

MEDICAL WASTES: Sharps containers are available at least one per fifty occupied stalls for the disposal of needles and other sharp medical waste.

NUMBER OF ENTRIES IN CLASSES: In the event there are less than three (3) entries in a class, there will be no prize money awarded relative to that class. Exhibitors are given the option to withdraw from that class and their entry fee for that class will be refunded provided the exhibitor or authorized representative make the withdrawal at the Show Secretary's office no later than one (1) hour before the session in which that class is held is to start. The Show Committee reserves the right to combine or split classes as deemed necessary. These will be posted at least one (1) hour before start of show.

PERFORMANCE CHAMPIONSHIPS: Horses placing first, second, or third in certain qualifying classes are required to show in the respective championship classes or forfeit winnings. Exempt are veterinarian excused horses. To be eligible to show in a Performance Championship class, a horse must be properly entered, shown and judged in one qualifying class in the same division or section.

POST ENTRIES: Post entries for all classes except working cow (for working cow see below) will be accepted if made at least one hour prior to the beginning of the session in which the class is to be held. A one-time \$30.00 per horse post entry fee will be charged. Horses entered by April 20, 2012 may enter additional classes at the show and not be subject to the post entry fee. **Working cow post entries:** No post entries will be allowed for Working Cow after May 1. Post entries after April 20 and before May 1 will have a one-time working cow horse post entry fee of \$65.00.

PRIZE MONEY AND ACCOUNTING: Prize money will be credited to all accounts, where applicable, in the show office. If a credit balance remains on the account, a check will be sent to the name on the account within 30 days of the last day of the show. Prize money checks will be honored for sixty (60) days from the issuance. After that time, all accounts will be considered closed providing that all fees have been paid.

PRIZE LIST CHANGES AND/OR CORRECTIONS: Changes and/or corrections to the Premium, if any, will be posted on the Club's website, www.gcaha.org

PROTECTIVE HEADGEAR: Riders in all classes where jumping is required and when jumping anywhere on the competition grounds must wear protective headgear which passes or surpasses ASTM/SEI standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. (Exception: Trail classes). Juniors riding in Hunter, Jumper and Hunter Seat Equitation sections, while riding anywhere on the competition grounds, must wear properly fitting protective headgear which passes or surpasses ASTM/SEI standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag.

PROTESTS: A protest must be filed as set forth in USEF Equestrian rules and/or AHA Code of Ethics rules.

REFUSAL OF ENTRIES: The show Management will be governed by USEF rules with respect to refusal of entries for this show.

RESPONSIBILITY: All entries are accepted with the understanding that neither Green Country Arabian Horse Association nor the Tulsa Fairgrounds will be responsible for any loss, personal injury, or damage to any horse exhibited or for any article of any kind or nature that may be lost or destroyed or in any way damaged. All horses shall be under the control and direction of the Show Committee but solely at the risk of the exhibitor who will be responsible for any loss, damage, or injury of any person, animal or property occasioned by him or his agents or employees, or by any animal owned or exhibited by him, and shall indemnify the Green Country Arabian Horse Association and the Tulsa Fairgrounds against any and all legal costs, including attorney fees which may be the result thereof. The submitting of any entry form to the Show Secretary shall constitute an acceptance of the provisions herein set forth.

RV PARKING: RV hook ups with electricity and water are available. Please call Tulsa Expo Square directly at 918-744-1113 ext 2154 for more information and to reserve a spot.

SALE/LEASE: In the event of a lessee, pending transfer, contract of sale, or cash sale, proof of lease or ownership must be submitted. These documents must contain the correct registered name and number of the horse, date, and the signature of the seller or lessee and must be attached to the copy of the registration certificate.

SCRATCHING CLASSES: Exhibitors or their representative must scratch from their class before the beginning of the Session that their class is in. Failure to do so will result in a \$10.00 fine. Exhibitors or their representative must do this in the show office, not in the paddock, the arena end gate, or at the announcers stand or fine will be accessed.

SHOW ACCOUNTS: Any exhibitor wishing to start a tab at the Show Office will be required to leave a signed check.

SHOW OFFICE HOURS: Show office will open Wednesday, May 2nd at 1 PM. Show office will open Thursday, May 3rd at 7 AM, Friday, May 4th at 7 AM, Saturday, May 5th at 7 AM, and Sunday May 6th at 7 AM. The show office will remain open throughout the show. The show office will close one hour after the end of the show.

STALLIONS are not allowed in showmanship or walk-trot classes.

STALLS: Stalls are 10 X 10 and are on asphalt floors with a door. Stalls and alleyways must be kept clean. Horse tie out is available with a ground tie fee of \$10 per day per horse, no overnight. Stalls can be reserved by sending in the appropriate stall fees but no stalls will be held without payment. **Arabian/Dressage exhibitors:** Pay one stall fee for all shows. Make a note on the entry that you have paid the other show if you do not include stall payment.

VETERINARIAN: A veterinarian will be on call. Information will be posted at Show Office.

WITHDRAWING ENTRIES: Entries may be scratched from the show PRIOR TO April 20th, 2012 with a total refund of all fees. After that date, withdrawals accompanied by a veterinarian's certificate of inability to show will receive refunds of class entry fees only.

Motorized Vehicle Statement

In accordance with GR1301.7:

Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent(s), legal guardian(s), or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Chapter 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

CLASS SPECIFICATIONS: This show is conducted in accordance with the rules of the USEF, Arabian Horse Division. **EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT USEF RULE BOOK WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH.** Any changes or corrections of the rules will be automatically become part of this premium list. Each participant in the show is responsible for knowledge of and is subject to the USEF Rules. Exhibitors are encouraged to read the USEF Rule book, and particularly the complete Arabian and Half-Arabian Horse rules, class descriptions and judging specifications. The show committee will decide questions not covered by the USEF Rules, and its decision will be final.

Adult Walk-Trot – English, Country English, Hunter, or Western tack and attire. Will be judged on attitude, manners, performance, suitability of horse to rider, quality and conformation. Riders in this class are not allowed to enter into any canter classes at this show. Will enter the ring counter-clockwise at a walk. To be shown both directions of the ring at the walk and trot/jog only.

AHA Medal classes: If a class does not fill, that is if the class does not have at least **THREE** competitors with proper appointments, the class will be held as a regular equitation class with pattern. No medal will be awarded if the class is conducted as a regular Equitation Class.

Amateur - Every rider having reached his 18th birthday prior to 12/1/11 must have in his/her possession an amateur card issued yearly by USEF or make application for such card at least one hour prior to riding in Amateur To Ride classes. Applications may be secured from the horse show office. See USEF GR808. Non-members who wish to show in Amateur Classes are also subject to a \$30 USEF amateur certification fee (in addition to \$30 non-member fee). Non-members may choose to become a USEF member for \$55, which then waives the \$30 non-member fee and the \$30 amateur fee.

Amateur owners – Combined ownership is not permitted in Amateur Owner classes unless all owners are members of the same family. Leased horses are not eligible for amateur owner classes. Horses entered in amateur owner and junior owner classes must be registered in the name of the competitor or a member of the competitor's family, as defined by USEF GR122. The sale of a horse does not eliminate this requirement. (Contracts of Sale or Bill of Sale will not be accepted.)

AOTS - Amateur Owned, Trained, and Shown - Classes may be offered in any section. Exhibitors, attendants, and headers must meet the specifications for amateur status (refer to GR1306 and GR1307). Horses are not to have been professionally trained and/or shown by a professional for a period of one year immediately prior to the competition (riding and driving instruction for the owner to be excluded). In addition, horses are not to be exhibited, prepared, groomed or schooled with the aid of or by a professional while on or off the competition grounds immediately before or during the competition. Horses may be stabled with a professional during the competition, and hauled by a professional. Professional help for situations relevant to safety is permitted. Owner must sign as owner, trainer, and rider/driver/handler on the USEF/AHA entry blank.

Breeding/Gelding in-hand classes will use the In the Ring Class Procedure. You can view this procedure in the 2012 USEF Rule book AR107. Half-Arabian and Anglo-Arabian Show Champions and Reserve Champions shall be at least two years old and are selected as outlined in GR810.5. Half-Arabian and Anglo-Arabian yearling geldings may compete for Champion gelding. Purebred yearling geldings may compete for Champion gelding. In a Breeding section of the Arabian division, the Junior, Senior or Show (Grand) Championship will be awarded to one of the horses which has placed first in a qualifying class. Qualifying classes for championships must be designated in the prize list. After the Championship has been awarded, the horse which has placed second in the qualifying class to the horse awarded the Championship shall compete with the remaining first place winners for the Reserve Championship. If a Show (Grand) Championship class is held, the Senior Champion and the Reserve Senior Champion as well as the top two ranking two year-olds will be eligible to compete. (Exception: AR108.1).

Classic Head: 1) Open to purebred stallions, mares and geldings. When only one Classic Head class is offered, the entries shall be two years old and over. 2) Horses must be shown in a plain, unmarked sheet or cooler. 3) To enter the ring at a walk and line up for further inspection. 4) The head shall be comparatively small with the profile of the head straight or preferably slightly concave below the eyes. The muzzle shall be small with large nostrils, extended when in action. The eyes shall be large, round, expressive and dark, set well apart. Glass eyes shall be penalized. There should be comparatively short distance between the eye and the muzzle with deep jowls, wide between the branches. Correctness of bite must be considered. The ears shall be small (smaller in stallions than mares), thin and well shaped, tips curved slightly inward.

Equitation: All equitation classes shall be governed in accordance with USEF rules as modified by the AHA Equitation rules in the current AHA handbook.

Hunter Hack - To be shown at a walk, trot and canter. Eight horses, if available, but never more than eight at a time, are required to hand gallop one direction of the ring. Horses are also required to jump two fences 2' - 2'6" in height. To be judged on performance, manners and soundness. This class does not count toward any Championship. Riders will have the opportunity to school over jumps prior to the start of the class. Protective headgear is required for this class.

Leadline: Open to riders who are at least two years of age and have not reached their seventh birthday as of December 1, 2009. Rider is exempt from AHA and USEF membership requirements. Refer to the USEF rule book Subchapter AR-28 Leadline section for more information.

Liberty class – Time allowed per horse is 1.5 minutes with two handlers permitted in the ring. Must be caught within 1.5 minutes or entry will be disqualified. No splint boots, bell boots or whips over six feet. Music (if desired) must be provided to the show office prior to the beginning of the session. Tapes must be cued to the correct location, and clearly marked with horse's name, exhibitor number, and music title. To be judged on presence, animation, and way of going.

Limit Horse – A limit horse class is open to horses that have not won six (6) first place ribbons at Regular Member Shows of USEF or the Canadian Equestrian Federation in the particular performance division in which they are shown. A Limit entry is such from the date of the closing of entries for this show.

Limited Reined Cow Horse – will be run using the NRCHA rulebook <http://www.nrcha.com/rulebook.asp> Refer to Rule 19.4 in the rulebook.

Novice Horse – A novice horse class is open to horses that have not won three (3) first place ribbons at Regular Member Shows of USEF or the Canadian Equestrian Federation in the particular performance division in which they are shown. A Novice entry is such from the date of the closing of entries for this show.

Select Rider: Refer to USEF rulebook AR113 for definition of select rider. www.usef.org

Sport Horse in-Hand Champion and Reserve Champions: Must be at least two years old.

Training Tack Classes: Local Rule classes, conducted under the Arabian division rule for each division. Training attire and training tack are allowed, riders must have boots with heels. Safety of the horse and rider is paramount. Horses must not interfere with other rides in the class. May enter other classes with appropriate equipment.

Walk-Trot Classes: Open to riders 10 years old and under. A rider must have never been judged in a class at a recognized or non-recognized competition that required a lope or canter. Stallions are prohibited. See USEF Rule AR222. Riders are not allowed to cross-enter any other classes except Breeding/In-Hand, Showmanship, or other Walk-Trot classes.

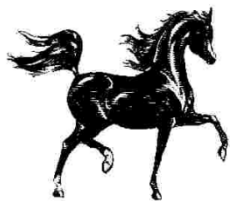

I have read the rules concerning competitions as printed in the Arabian Horse Association (AHA) Handbook and Directory and agree to be bound by and subject to those Rules.

AHA ASSUMPTION OF RISK, RELEASE AND INDEMNIFICATION

This document waives very important legal rights. Read it carefully before signing.

In consideration for AHA permitting me to participate in this Competition, and by signing the entry blank, I agree as follows:

I AGREE that I choose to participate voluntarily in this Competition, as a rider, driver, handler, lessee, owner, agent, coach, trainer, junior exhibitor, or as a parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor. **I AM FULLY AWARE AND ACKNOWLEDGE THAT HORSE SPORTS AND PARTICIPATION IN THIS COMPETITION INVOLVE SERIOUS RISK OF HARM INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, RISKS OF ACCIDENT, SERIOUS BODILY INJURY, INCLUDING DEATH, BROKEN BONES, HEAD INJURIES, TRAUMA, PAIN, AND SUFFERING, AND PROPERTY DAMAGE. I ASSUME ALL RISKS OF HARM TO ME, MY HORSE OR MY PROPERTY.**

I AGREE for myself, my heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns to **release** AHA, the Competition, the facilities leased by the Competition and the owner(s) of the facilities, and all of their respective officers, officials, directors, employees, agents, personnel, volunteers, affiliated organizations and insurers (collectively, the "Released Parties") from any and all claims **for damage, loss, or injury to myself, other persons, horses or other property** belonging to me to the fullest extent permitted by law that arises out of or relates in any way to the Competition and my participation in the Competition **INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, DAMAGES, LOSS, OR INJURY RESULTING FROM ANY ACTS, FAILURE TO ACT, NEGLIGENCE OR NEGLECT OF OTHER ENTRANTS, THE RELEASED PARTIES, THEIR CONTRACTORS OR INVITEES**, as well as for theft, vandalism, fire, other casualty damage, or damage arising out of any defects in the premises.

I AGREE to indemnify and hold harmless (that is pay all losses, damages, attorneys fees and costs of) the Released Parties from and against any and all claims, demands, penalties, actions, losses costs, damages, injuries, liabilities and obligations (including attorneys fees) of whatsoever kind and nature, which may be asserted against or incurred by any of them as a result of (1) my participation in the Competition or (2) any act, failure to act, or neglect (a) by me, my agents, employees, riders, handlers, trainers, coaches, drivers, contractors or invitees, or (b) by any animal owned or exhibited by me or in my custody or control.

I AGREE to accept AS FINAL any decision of AHA, the Show Commission or Show Officials concerning my qualification or the qualification of my horse to enter the Competition or any results of the Competition, except to the extent that the Rules of AHA, the Competition, Equine Canada or U.S. Equestrian Federation permit a protest or hearing of such decisions. Should a hearing be requested, **I agree to accept AS FINAL** the decision of the particular hearing body. **I agree to release, hold harmless and not to sue AHA**, the Competition Sponsor, their officers, directors, employees, volunteers or members concerning any decision of AHA, the Competition, its Show Commission, Show Officials or any hearing body that relates to my qualifications or my horse(s)' qualifications to enter the Competition or any results of the Competition.

I AGREE that AHA has the sole right to control, sell, supervise or give away (or assign to others the right to do so) the exclusive rights to broadcast, televise, reproduce, transmit and disseminate all or part of this event, and I agree that AHA may use or assign, in any way AHA sees fit, photographs, films, videos, audios, cablecasts, or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the Competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the Competition or AHA. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way which implies endorsement of any company, product, product category or service. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation.

By signing below as a parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor, I consent to the child's participation and agree to all of the above provisions, and further agree to assume all of the obligations of this AHA Assumption of Risk, Release and Indemnification personally and on behalf of the child.

This AHA Assumption of Risk, Release and Indemnification is governed by the Laws of the State of Colorado and is intended to be interpreted as broadly as possible.
