

VOLUNTEER POSITIONS

- Ring person – Act as an aid to judge. Relay judge's instructions to announcer clearly. Watch for potential problems in the ring.
- Gate person - Open and/or close gates at the beginning and end of the class and at other times as needed.
- Paddock person - Check horses in for upcoming classes. Communicate with show secretary and announcer any problems, tack holds, or horses not checked in for upcoming classes.
- Ribbon person – Hand out ribbons after each class to exhibitors as they are leaving the ring.
- Sport horse in hand Scribe –Must be able to listen and record the judge's comments accurately and consistently.
- Sport horse in hand Runner - Collect score sheets from the scribe and carry them to the scorers in a fast and unobtrusive manner.
- Sport horse in hand Scorer – Add up the scores directly from the sport horse in hand sheet tests using an adding machine with a tape.
- Sport horse in hand Results – Take the score sheets and place the class. Transfer that information to a master sheet to be posted. Tabulate sport horse high point.
- Trail course designer – Create trail courses based on USEF rules. Provide copies of trail course to Judge, Steward, and Show Secretary for posting. Be available to set the trail course, re-set the course during the class, and remove the trail course.
- Runner - Fill in wherever something is needed.
- Silent Auction - Collect money after it ends.
- Silent Auction - Answer questions and sell raffle tickets when the auction is open.
- Hospitality –Make sure the judge and workers have refreshments available. This might include bringing ice (club will reimburse) to fill coolers and making sure coolers are stocked.
- Working Cow Horse Scribe – Write what the judges say correctly on the score sheets. Calculate final score.
- Center Ring – Decorate and set up center ring. Creative minds are welcome!
- Barn manager – Assign stalls and create stall chart to be posted. Put name tags on stalls the day before move in. Be available as people are arriving in case of problems.
